

Important Notice: Storm Preparations and Service Updates


Dear Homeowners,

Hurricane Milton Update

Hurricane Milton is currently a Category 4 storm with sustained winds of 155 mph. The latest National Hurricane Center update forecasts it to make landfall near or just south of Tampa later today as a Category 3 or 4 hurricane.

For Alaqua Lakes, we can expect storm-force winds starting this evening around 4:00 pm. The worst of the weather will occur overnight into

Thursday morning, with sustained winds of 60-70 mph and gusts up to 75+ mph. The storm conditions should pass by Thursday afternoon.

Please remain aware of potential flooding as we can expect up to 15+ inches in rain as well as possible tornadoes due to the wind. <u>Residents are</u> <u>encouraged to sign up for weather alerts directly from Seminole County</u> <u>to stay informed of alerts in our area</u>.
