

Tropical Storm Milton Update and 10/7 Special Meeting Cancellation



Good Afternoon Alaqua Lakes,

Tropical Storm Milton has formed in the Gulf and is expected to strengthen into a hurricane by tonight. While there are still many unknowns, it is currently forecasted to reach the Florida west coast as a Category 3 by Wednesday, 10/9.

Residents should begin their storm preparations now and be ready for damaging winds, flooding rain, and tornadoes. Heavy rainfall is expected from today through Wednesday, with a Flood Watch in effect until Thursday morning. Tropical storm winds may arrive as early as Tuesday evening, with stronger gusts likely by Wednesday morning.

The Association is working with our vendors to ensure storm readiness and cleanup. Due to these preparations, the Special Meeting on 10/7 is canceled, and pressure washing and palm tree trimming will be

discussed at the 10/17 board meeting.
